



College Level Examination Program (CLEP) Computer Based Testing (CBT)

Exams are administered by appointment only. Appointments must be made in person. You must have a valid photo ID to test. Registration is limited per test date, early registration is recommended. For additional questions contact the UNM Testing Center at 277-5346.

*Starting January 1st, 2014 **ALL** examinees must create an account with CLEP (<http://clep.collegeboard.org/>) to select the test that will be taken and to pay for the CLEP exam. Examinees will then be issued a registration ticket to confirm CLEP test payment. Registration tickets **must** be presented when scheduling an appointment for CLEP and on test day.

*One payable to **CLEP**: Contact CLEP for fee information. **Must** be paid online to CLEP & registration ticket must be presented when scheduling appointment

*Applicable fees are separate for UNM Administration Fee and CLEP Exam Fee.

***If you cannot make your scheduled appointment please call to cancel and/or to reschedule, otherwise you will be charged the \$20 registration fee to make a new appointment.**
