



DSST Program Internet Based Testing (IBT)

Exams are administered by appointment only. Appointments must be made in person. You must have a photo ID to test. Registration is limited per test date, early registration is recommended. For special accommodations or additional questions contact the UNM Testing Center at 277-5346.

Registration Fees: (Non-Refundable)

UNM: \$20.00. Visit our website (test.unm.edu) and visit payment tab for details.

DSST: \$80.00 (Credit Card **Only**)

Total Regular Test Fee per Test: \$100.00

Applicable fees are separate for UNM Administration Fee and DSST Exam Fee.

If it is not listed you must contact Thomson Prometric at 866-794-3497 **prior** to taking your exam. Otherwise, if left blank at the time of testing, you will have to pay a \$30 transcript fee when ordered at a later date.

The following DSST tests must be ordered at least 10 days prior to testing:

- Technical Writing- if taking optional essay (must determine if required by credit granting institution)
- Ethics in America- if taking optional essay (must determine if required by credit granting institution)

Therefore, students should contact their college advisors for specific information. No credit is granted for Subject Exams not listed below. Students should be aware that DSST Examinations are intended for people with clear strengths in an area. **IMPORTANT:** There is a 3-month waiting period before repeating a test.
